GENERAL SERVICE TIME-OF-DAY (OFF-PEAK)

Rate Code: GS-TOD

APPLICABLE:

To single-phase or three-phase general service customers, at the option of the customer and with the approval of the Association, adjacent to existing facilities of adequate capacity where the transformer capacity does not exceed 50 kVA, and subject to the rules of the Association and Regulatory Authorities.

AVAILABLE:

In territory served by the Wheatland REA adjacent to existing facilities.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Single-phase or three-phase, 60 hertz, at available secondary voltage.

MONTHLY RATE:

WINTER (October through March)

Facilities Charge:

Single-Phase Service \$37.25 per month

Three-Phase Service \$51.25 per month

Energy Charge:

On-Peak: \$0.13896 per kWh

Off-Peak: \$0.06116 per kWh

SUMMER (April through September)

Facilities Charge:

Single-Phase \$34.25 per month

Three-Phase \$51.25 per month

Energy Charge:

\$0.12433 per kWh

DEFINITION OF PEAK:

The winter on-peak period is from 12:00 PM through 10:00 PM every day during the months of September through April. Off-peak Hours are all hours not specified as on-peak.

MINIMUM BILL:

The monthly minimum bill shall be the highest of the following, subject to the provisions of the line extension policies:


- A. \$37.25 for Single-Phase Service
- B. \$51.25 for Three-Phase Service
- C. \$1.00 per kVA of transformer capacity, or
- D. As specified in contract for service.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

- A. Service under this tariff requires a contract of not less than one (1) year.
- B. Payment for all bills for electric service must be postmarked 10 (10) days following the date of bill mailing. Bills not paid by the next following bill date may be assessed a one-and-one-half percent (1.5%) late payment charge. This charge will be on the delinquent balance brought forward on the subsequent month's bill. All payments received shall satisfy the oldest portion of the billing first.
