LARGE POWER

Rate Code: LP

APPLICABLE:

To consumers requiring three-phase service within the service area of the Association subject to the rules and regulations of the Association and of Regulatory Authorities.

AVAILABLE:

To three-phase service adjacent to existing facilities of adequate capacity where required transformer capacity exceeds 50 kVA.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Three-phase, 60 hertz, at available secondary voltage.

MONTHLY RATE:

Facilities Charge:	\$75.00 per Month
Plus	
Demand Charge:	\$10.64 per kW per Month
Plus	
Energy Charge:	
First 50,000 kWh	\$0.12470 per kWh
Over 50,000 kWh	\$0.10250 per kWh.

MONTHLY MINIMUM BILL:

The monthly minimum charge under the above rate shall be the highest of the following, subject to the provisions of the line extension policies:

- A. \$75.00 plus the charges for demand and energy used; or
- B. \$1.00 per kVA of transformer capacity required; or
- C. As specified in contract for service.

TERM OF CONTRACT:

Not less than one year.

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND:

The billing demand at each station shall be the maximum kilowatts of demand established by the consumer for any period of fifteen (15) consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered, as indicated or recorded by a demand meter and adjusted for power factor as provided below.

POWER FACTOR ADJUSTMENT:

Demand charges will be adjusted to correct for average power factors lower than ninety-five percent (95%) if and when Association deems necessary. Such adjustments shall be made by increasing the measured demand one percent (1%) for each one percent (1%) by which the average power factor is less than ninety-five percent (95%) leading or lagging.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Payment for all bills for electric service must be postmarked ten (10) days following the date of bill mailing. Bills not paid by the next following bill date may be assessed a one and one-half percent (1.5%) late payment charge. This charge will be on the delinquent balance brought forward on the subsequent month's bill.

Payments received shall satisfy the oldest portion of the billing first.

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
